SWIMMING POOL ELECTRICAL SAFETY REQUIREMENTS AFFIDAVIT**

I _____, license # _____, hereby affirm that an electrical equipotential bonding system will be installed in accordance with NFPA 70, National Electrical Code, current adopted edition, for the swimming pool and/or spa at _____, Pensacola, FL. I agree to the following conditions:

- All pool and spa grounding and bonding shall be done by a Florida licensed electrical contractor. The pool contractor or any other entity will not perform any electrical work on this project. Exception: A qualified Owner Builder performing their own electrical work per 489.503, Florida Statutes.
- All wiring and electrical work shall comply with Article 680 of the current adopted edition of NFPA 70, National Electrical Code
- All fittings, clamps, and splicing devices shall be listed for the purpose and installed per the manufacturer's instructions and listing.
- All items specified in 680.26(B)(1) through (B)(7) shall be installed as applicable to the type of pool being installed.
- All underwater luminaires, if required to be bonded, shall be done in accordance with 680.23.
- If there are no bonded parts in direct contact with the water, a water bond shall be provided in accordance with 680.26(C)

I understand that not scheduling and passing the required Pool Grounding Inspection(s) prior to covering up, encasing in concrete, or installing pool finishes, shall result in removal of materials to verify compliance. I understand that there are no alternatives to verifying compliance other than an onsite inspection by the City Electrical Inspector.
