Minimum Preparation for Work:

College or high school student, 18- to 24-years old, who resides or attends school in Escambia County with sufficient education to demonstrate an ability to read and write and follow written instructions.

Necessary Special Requirements

This is semiskilled mechanical work in the installation of gas facilities. An employee in this class works as a member of a crew engaged in gas distribution and service work under supervision. The employee regularly lifts and/or moves up to 50 pounds and occasionally lifts and/or moves up to 100 pounds.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to use hands and fingers to hold or feel, reach with hands and arms, walk, talk, smell, and hear. The employee is occasionally required to stand, sit, climb, balance, stoop, crouch, and crawl. Specific vision abilities include close, distance, color, and peripheral vision, and depth perception.

Examples of Work:

- Digs ditches, unloads pipe, patches streets, and performs other manual labor functions as assigned.
- Assists in the repair of gas leaks.
- Assist in installing services, locating mains, and leaks.
- Assists in maintaining supplies and equipment.

Work Environment:

The noise level in the work environment is usually moderate. Some jobs may require an employee to be exposed to outside weather conditions, wet and/or humid conditions.
